Rikochalle Summer of 2024
Workshop for Female Students to Learn about Opportunities at Foreign Financial Institutions

Tokyo – Citi announced that it will host a workshop for female students of junior high school, high school and university, Rikochalle Summer of 2024, on Friday, August 23, 2024, to give students an overview of the financial industry, and the operations of the work involved as well as a talk session with female employees with a science or engineering background. Citi has supported the initiative since 2022 as a virtual workshop. The event for 2024 will be held in person for the first time.

Riko Challenge (Rikochalle: STEM Challenge), is an initiative led by the Gender Equality Bureau of the Cabinet Office to encourage female high school and university students to take an interest in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM).

Citi is committed to a culture of respect for diversity and has established three pillars: Citi Disability, Citi Pride and Citi Women, and promotes an equal and inclusive culture where each employee can be proud and perform to their full potential. Pillar's initiatives and activities are run by volunteer employees.

Citi Women, which promotes the active participation of female employees, based on the belief that it is necessary to increase the number of female human resources at the recruitment stage, Citi Women decided to participate in "Rikochalle" as it did last year with the aim of being actively involved in future talent development. By introducing youth to careers in finance through the event, it aims to support more women to consider entering the science and engineering field without hesitation.
